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Four Pillars of Successful OGMP Implementation

Validere practitioner framework for programme diagnostics. Not a UNEP designation. Based on the OGMP 2.0 Framework, related guidance, and common implementation patterns.

1. Complete inventory

Asset / site / source hierarchy and Level 3 map for materiality

2. Representative measurement

Question-led source and site designs; independent methods for Level 5

3. Governed reconciliation

Compare, investigate, adjust, and learn year over year

4. Continuous improvement

Risk-based frequency, mitigation feedback, reusable evidence

If you are starting tomorrow

- ☐ Build one shared asset / site / source hierarchy with operations, HSE, and sustainability
- ☐ Finish Level 3 inventory before commissioning new measurement campaigns
- ☐ Identify material assets (95% absolute emissions) and rank sources inside them
- ☐ Map every technology purchase to a Level 4 method need or Level 5 reconciliation need
- ☐ Assign owners for reconciliation findings, method versions, and May submission evidence

Year 0–1 foundation

- ☐ MoU complete; reporting calendar set through 31 May
- ☐ Operated + NOJV (≥5% equity) asset universe with operator and equity flags
- ☐ Complete Level 3 source inventory for ranking
- ☐ Portfolio and asset materiality documented
- ☐ Methane target set; implementation plan drafted by asset
- ☐ Evidence standards defined (method versions, campaign metadata, approvals)

Year 2 Level 4 depth

- ☐ Level 4 methods prioritized on largest sources in largest assets
- ☐ Sampling designed for skewed / fat-tailed distributions
- ☐ Source-level and site-level campaigns kept methodologically independent
- ☐ Uncertainty quantified where it can change decisions
- ☐ Method-change vs real-reduction effects separated in management reporting
- ☐ Level 5 pilot scoped (bounded sites / populations)

- ☐ NOJV data requests and barriers documented

Year 3+ reconciliation readiness

- ☐ Reconciliation workspace: compare → investigate → adjust → revise Level 4 → replan
- ☐ May submission package produced from governed data, not spreadsheet rebuilds
- ☐ Reconciled results used to redirect mitigation spend
- ☐ Materiality refreshed after significant portfolio or emissions change
- ☐ NOJV path progressing on five-year clock with visible effort

Common failure mode: Prioritizing measurement hardware before governance. Fix hierarchy, Level 3 completeness, and ownership first. Then deepen Level 4 methods. Then reconcile at scale.
